How To Report Issues such as Encampments, Illegal Dumping and Graffiti

KNOW YOUR JURISDICTION: City, County or State

Land in Studio City can fall under various jurisdictions, so reporting to the correct authority is key to getting a response. Generally speaking, the City of LA services Studio City Streets, Sidewalks, Parks, LA River and Personal Property. Caltrans services areas near freeways, bridges and Offramps
