

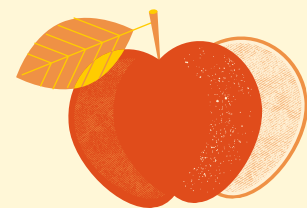
COMPOST WITH CD4!



BIG NEWS, ANGELENOS! All residences served by LA Sanitation* will soon be required to participate in organics recycling, as per California Senate Bill 1383.
