To begin, stakeholders need to request a ballot. Use this <u>link</u> to complete a ballot request form to be mailed to your home. The deadline to request ballots is June 2, 2025. We will have hard copies of the ballot request form at Thursday's meeting, and will file them with the city for you on Friday morning, if you prefer. The ballot request form is a short document and just takes a minute to complete.

You will then receive a ballot from the City complete with a postage-paid envelope. Fill out your ballot and return it by June 10. Ballots postmarked June 10 will be accepted and votes will be tabulated until June 20, 2025.
