Motion B: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council supports Mayor Garcetti's initiative to lower the civilian injury-leave pay for City employees to 66% of base pay from the current 90% of base pay.

Motion C: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council supports the City Attorney report and the proposed ordinance relative to amending Section 56.11, Article 6, Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit the storage of personal property in public areas.
