MOTION TO ADOPT COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT

The Studio City Neighborhood Council recommends that the City Council amend this important motion to include the category "sexual orientation" in recordkeeping of bias complaints against the Los Angeles Fire Department. According to the Los Angeles Neighborhood Council Gay & Lesbian Caucus, there are currently no openly gay or lesbian firefighters among the 3,382 uniformed LAFD personnel. This lack of proportional representation might reasonably be attributed to fear of harassment, bias in promotion practices and other forms of retaliation based on real or perceived sexual orientation.
