- 2. Approval of April 2017 Board Minutes. **Approved** in the absence of objection.
- 3. Update by the President. Denise Welvang welcomed the stakeholders.
- 4. Public Comments on non-agenda items within the Board's jurisdiction. **Susan Hunter** from Measure S introduced herself. She reported that they are shifting focus to the General Plan update.
- 5. Geoff Yazzetta, Deputy District Director, District 2 introducing Jessica Fugate the new District 2 Field Representative. Geoff Yazzetta reintroduced himself and introduced Jessica Feugate who will be our field deputy. Jessica Fugate introduced herself. Most recently she came from CD4 but she was originally from Baltimore. Geoff Yazzetta reported on the status of the proposed Harvard Westlake Parking Structure. They have applied for some permits but no hearing has been set and no permits issued. He reported that the new SLO is going through the mentoring process candidates are doing 2 month rotations. The City has a 9.2 billion budget this year. That is a 5.2% increase from prior year. Andrew Sussman joined the meeting. City department. Motion Carried.

Motion A: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council opposes adoption of an ordinance creating affordable housing units by establishing a process for granting legal status to certain existing unpermitted dwelling units in multiple-family buildings, and amending Subsections (a) and (e) of Section 19.14 of Chapter 1 to clarify the applicability of previously approved fees to the administration of the program. Our opposition is based upon (i) the resulting increase in density through the use of State density bonus provisions requiring incorporation of restricted affordable units into the existing buildings without providing parking required if the units were not given the exemption proposed in the ordinance, and (ii) the failure to actively enforce the requirement to reserve and maintain the Affordable Units for 55 years.

This motion should be filed as a CIS to CF 14-1150-S1. Motion Withdrawn the City Council has already acted upon this matter.
