



North Outfall Sewer Rehabilitation Unit 29 Construction Update: New Traffic Impacts on Colfax Ave.



Project Information

The North Outfall Sewer (NOS) Unit 29 project will rehabilitate the sewer system in your area. This project is needed to address severe deterioration of the sewer pipes, and will include a number of improvements for a more reliable sewer system for decades to come. This rehabilitation can help prevent sewer failures, or issues that can be associated with the deterioration of sewer pipes.

Construction Activities

We will construct an access pit on Colfax Avenue and will put additional traffic control in place to maintain safety while this pit is being constructed, and for the duration of its use. This activity may take place concurrently with ongoing work at other sites along the project's alignment.

- Setup of No Parking and Traffic Control on Colfax Ave.
- Excavation of pavement, shoring, and construction of access pit
- Use of access pit to install a new liner to rehabilitate the NOS sewer line from within the pipe
- Backfill of access pit, roadway re-striping, and work site restoration

Work Schedule and Location

Time: Monday-Friday, 7:00am-4:00pm

When: Traffic Control and No Parking setup to begin 10/30/2023
Construction of the access pit to begin the week of 11/6/2023

The access pit and traffic control are anticipated to remain in place for a duration of ~ 9 months.

Where: The access pit will be located on Colfax Ave. at Valley Spring Lane. The traffic control and no parking Area will be located on Colfax Ave. between Acama & Woodbridge.

What you need to know

- **Colfax Avenue will be one lane in each direction between Acama & Woodbridge. This traffic pattern will be maintained 24/7 for safety.**
- Temporary "No Parking" in work zones with advanced notice on Colfax Ave. between Acama & Woodbridge.
- Driveway, trash, and delivery access will be maintained.
- You may see **trucks, construction workers, heavy equipment, and supplies** during the sewer repair work.
- Some **noise, dust, and vibration** is associated with this type of construction activities. Mitigation will be in place.
- Project Construction Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.
- After this repair is completed, there will be additional work for this project. You will receive another notification with more information on these additional work items prior to their start.
